

BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board of Education may, from time to time, establish committees whose membership will consist of members of the Board. The president of the Board shall serve as an ex-officio member of all committees to which he/she is not appointed. Board committees shall undertake studies and make reports as charged by the Board, but shall not act on behalf of the Board. No committee appointed hereunder shall act, or shall represent itself as having the authority to act, on behalf of the Board, except with express authority from the Board to do so.

A committee appointed hereunder shall visit each school under the supervision of the Board at least once annually. Said committee shall report at the next regularly scheduled meeting after its visit on the condition of that school.

The Board may establish standing or ad hoc committees and reserves the right to terminate any committees at any time.

Any official policy-level action shall be in the sole discretion of the Board. The Board is in no way obligated to follow committee recommendations. The Board has the right to accept, reject, or modify all or any part of a committee recommendation.
