

## QUORUM

The Board of Education recognizes that it may transact business only when a quorum of its membership is present. A simple majority of the total number of members established for the Board shall constitute a quorum. This requires that when only the number of members necessary to constitute a quorum is present, no motion or resolution may pass, and no other action or business requiring a vote may be transacted, except by a unanimous vote of those present.

The Board shall not require a vote in excess of what is required by law in order for the Board to transact any business.
