

## Kindergarten Classroom Supply List

### Miss Mensing - Room 3

Your child will be using these items on a daily basis for a variety of classroom projects. Many of the items will be shared with the entire class, as we frequently work together.

1. One box of crayons - 16-36 count
2. One box of washable markers
3. One box of thin washable markers
4. One bottle of glue
5. 20-30 Glue Sticks (I know it seems like a lot, but we go through glue sticks very quickly)!
6. 10 Sharpened Pencils
7. Clorox (or similar type) disinfecting wipes - we use them to wipe down the tables very frequently.
8. Small plastic drinking cups (5 ounce size works great).
9. A smock for art projects (an old shirt is best)  
This will be left in class and sent home periodically for washing
10. A pump bottle of liquid hand soap and/or liquid hand sanitizer
11. A box of tissues
12. A resting towel to be used during "quiet time"
13. A container of baby wipes (for cleaning messy hands after art projects, etc)
14. One box of quart size and gallon size Ziploc (or similar type) plastic bags
15. You may want to send in a change of clothes for your child. Clothes will be kept in your child's cubby and should be stored in a plastic bag with his or her name clearly displayed on the bag.
16. Sneakers will be needed every day for outside play and will be needed for gym class. You can store an extra pair in your child's cubby if you choose.
