EGCSD FREE & REDUCED MEAL ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINE REMINDER

At the beginning of the school year, the East Greenbush Central School District sent out notifications to parents of free and reduced meal availability for students. During the year, sometimes parental income decreases due to job loss, loss of overtime pay, or other changing financial circumstances. If a household income declines, students may become eligible for free and reduced meals. Please note that these income guidelines are maximum amounts. For example, if a family of four earns \$3,269 per month, or less, than they are eligible for reduced price meals. If, however, this same family of four earns more than \$3,269 per month they are not eligible for free or reduced price meals.
