

ANNUAL ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION 2016- 2017 SY

In compliance with State and Federal regulations, the East Greenbush Central School District is required to notify employee unions, Parent/Teacher Organizations and others that use school facilities, of the existence of known Asbestos Containing Building Materials (ACBM) located within District buildings.

Located in the Main Office of each school building is a binder named the “Asbestos Management Plan”. This document contains important information as to the location and condition of known ACBM within that particular building. Regulations require an annual notification of asbestos related activities that have recently occurred and any planned activity for the current school year.

Abatement activity conducted in the last year includes:

Bell Top Elementary – asbestos and vermiculite removal from attic and original building spaces

Citizen Genet Elementary – asbestos removal from basement crawl space and vinyl floor tile

Donald P. Sutherland Elementary – asbestos and vermiculite removal from original building

Goff Middle School – asbestos removal from below the kitchen slab

As per Federal Regulation, the District is required to perform 6-month surveillances of all known ACBM to confirm that continual monitoring of the condition of known ACBM is performed. The next surveillance will occur during the fall of 2016. In the summer of 2016 a Triennial Re-inspection of all District Buildings occurred.
