

# Blue Devils Tennis Camp

**What to expect**

Players will be broken into small groups based on ability. Each day there will be a shot of the day taught by the instructors to start the camp. Campers will then move through stations to improve all aspects of their tennis game. After stations there will be a short break. Players will then have the opportunity to play competitively or for fun. **The grades 10-12 camps will include guest coaches.**

All week long camps will have a presentation about playing tennis outside of school. Grades 3-8 will learn about opportunities to play in the community and grades 9-12 will learn about playing in college.

The three weeks of camp will focus on the basics of tennis. The camper will have instruction and stations to work on a skill and time to play tennis games.

The camp is run by the Varsity and JV coaches at Columbia High School. Both groups will have guest coaches from the local tennis community.

**Location and times**

Camps will run at the Columbia High School tennis courts. Drop off will start no earlier than 20 minutes before the start of camp and pick up is expected to be no later than 15 minutes after the end of camp. There will be rain day make-ups the following Saturday, times will be announced later.

**Cost**

Grades 10-12- \$75  
Grades 7-9 and 5-6 \$50  
Grades 3-4 \$30  
Multi-child discount: \$5 off for each additional camper.

**What will I need for camp?**

Every player is expected to wear sunscreen and bring water, a tennis racquet and a snack, if desired. There will be water for refills.

If you do not have a racquet, we have a few that can be loaned out for camp. Please notify us if you need one. They will be first come, first serve.
