## Board of Education Goals

### **GOAL #1** Maintain academic excellence

#### STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES:

- A. Develop and implement a strategic planning framework to ensure all schools and departments are focused on continuous improvement based on board and district goals
- B. Present proposed revisions to current district and board of education committees and a work flow chart for shared decision-making and communication
- C. Complete and sustain the curriculum mapping, assessment development process, evaluate results, make adjustments based on data
- D. Study, prioritize, and implement recommendations from the NYS Career and Technical Education Technical Assistance Center regarding the district's CTE and STEM programs
- E. Implement updated comprehensive Professional Development Plan based on student data, staff needs assessment and new NYSED requirements; align to the district's professional development calendar
- F. Provide collaborative, targeted professional development for staff to integrate new instructional delivery models associated with Project-Based Learning within our Career & Technical Education
- G. Complete revised technology plan; obtain board of education approval and begin implementation. Support classroom access to technology in order to prepare for computer based assessments and provide 1:1 instructional opportunities
- H. Study recommendations from 2016-17 Program Reviews in Library Media and Foreign Languages and develop a plan for aligned curriculum work and professional development
- I. Complete program reviews for AIS/RTI, K-12 Math, K-12 Art, K-12 Social Studies
- J. Build awareness and capacity for the implementation of the Next Generation Science Standards K-12

### **GOAL #2** Continue the process of educational and fiscal planning for the sustainability and future growth of the school community

#### STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES:

- A. Design and implement Phase 1 of the 2017-18 construction project
- B. Implement the District's Smart Bond Investment Plan
- C. Utilize consultant's population estimates and enrollment projections for community to inform the District's Long Range Plan
- D. Align long-range financial plan with current educational goals of the district

### **GOAL #3** Develop collaborative and active relationships between the school district, local community and broader educational organizations

#### STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES:

- A. Continue positive collaborative relationships and communication with town, county and state elected officials
- B. Expand leadership role and district involvement within Questar BOCES, CASDA, NYSCOSS and with local colleges to discuss student programs and increase professional collaboration
- C. Provide leadership and district involvement in Questar Business and Education Partnership Program
- D. Maintain recognition efforts of student, teacher, administrator, staff and District academic, artistic and athletic accomplishments, and share successes with the community and the media via electronic communications
- E. Establish and maintain cooperative advocacy for the funding needs of public education with community groups, internal District stakeholders, and surrounding school districts and BOCES organizations
- F. Operate as a regional leader on emerging issues
- G. Continue to develop educational and strategic partnerships with local school districts, institutes of higher education, businesses and government agencies

### **GOAL #4** Continue to uphold a safe environment and culture district-wide for all students and staff

#### STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES:

- A. Enhance district security infrastructure through capital project design, planning and implementation, provide training as required
- B. Implement enhanced training school safety on district-wide safety plans in collaboration with law enforcement, fire, and EMS agencies; Implement climate survey, provide training based on survey results
- C. Provide training to all newly hired staff regarding maintaining boundaries between staff and students including appropriate use of social media for communications; Provide follow up training to all staff on emerging issues
