Winter Coaches of the year: Ryan Jones and Anthony Servidone

Columbia winter coaches Ryan Jones and Anthony Servidone were named Times Union Coaches of the Year for the winter of 2018. Ryan Jones coached Columbia boys' indoor track to its first Section II team championship since 1983. Anthony Servidone coached Columbia wrestling to its first Section II Class A championship in program history. The Columbia Wrestling program also won the Suburban Council Division Title while coach Servidone surpassed the 300 career win mark during the season.
