Preparing for Regents and Mid-Term exams is no easy task. Luckily though, with the help of the internet, today's students have many options to practice tests and review key information. Here is a brief list of some locations where you might find some help. Check with your subject area teacher to see if he/she knows of any other sites that may help you.

#### 1) WWW.REGENTSPREP.ORG

This site is one stop shopping for Regents Exam preparation. If you are not yet familiar with this site, you should check it out now. It has practice regents questions, essays, and review material.

#### 2) WWW.REGENTSREVIEWLIVE.NET

You may have seen this show on local television. On this website you can watch these videos and access powerpoints on each subject. There are other resources available here as well.

#### 3) WWW.BARRONSREGENTS.COM

This review book company now has a website. For \$16.99 you get a one year subscription that gives you access to their entire database of New York State Regents prep tests in all regents subject areas. If you get it now you can also use it for next year's classes. In addition, you can do the following:

### Mid-Term Exams / Regents Week


CHS midterms and Regents exams will take place from Tuesday, <u>January</u> 26th to Friday, January 29th, 2016.

#### Regents/Local Exam Week—January 26th thru 29th, 2016

All Students must have their Student Identification Badge to enter a Regents or Local Exam. Any students who have lost or misplaced their Student Identification Badge must go to their Assistant Principal's office to receive one no later than a week prior to the exam.

**Cell Phones/Electronics** 

To further ensure the integrity of State assessments, the current policy is being enhanced to prohibit all students from bringing cell phones and certain other electronic devices into a classroom or other location where a

New York State assessment is being administered.

<u>Prohibited devices include, but</u> are not limited to:

- · Cell phones
- · BlackBerry devices and other PDAs
- · iPods and MP3 players
- · iPads, tablets, and other eReaders
- · Laptops, notebooks or any other personal computing devices
- · Cameras or other photographic equipment
- · Headphones, headsets, or inear headphones such as earbuds
- · Any device capable of recording audio, photographic or video content, or capable of viewing or playing back such content

Test proctors, test monitors, and

school officials, shall have the right to collect cell phones and other prohibited electronic devices prior to the start of the test and to hold them while the test is being administered, including break periods. Admission to the test shall be denied to any student who refuses to relinquish a prohibited device.

Students: Please do not bring prohibited devices to Columbia High School during Exam Week.



#### TIPS FOR STUDY SUCCESS


 Have clear goals for studying. For example, reread class notes and the assigned chapters in your textbooks every evening.


