Additionally, our math teachers would like to remind you that all students enrolled in these courses should have a TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator. The opportunity for your child to be successful on the June exam, and in his or her Algebra II course, is greatly increased with access to his or her own graphing calculator on a daily basis. Please remind your child to bring his or her graphing calculator to the exam. If he or she does not have one, a spare will be provided on the day of the exam.
