

Quick Facts for incoming 6th grade students

1. How many class periods are there each day? 9
2. What is detention? Not following rules. (Lunch, after school, teacher)
3. School Dress Code? Outlined in code of conduct you'll receive at the beginning of the year.
4. What modified (7th and 8th grade students) teams are available? Basketball, wrestling, football, baseball, track, field hockey, lacrosse... intramurals such as flag football and ironman are available to 6th grade students
5. What happens if you get lost in the hall? Teachers are in the hall for the first two weeks of school helping.
6. How do the lockers work? The lockers have a combination lock on them and you will be allowed to come to school before it starts for practice on "locker night"
7. Can you pick your own lunch table? Yes
8. Can you bring water bottles or snacks to class? Most teachers allow a snack during Team Time
9. When do you get your schedule and find out what team you are on? You will receive your schedule during the summer
10. How long between classes? 3 minutes
11. Will older students be in the same hallway? The sixth grade wing has primarily 6th grade students
12. How much homework will you have? 1 hour on average
13. What is the cell phone policy? Keep in your locker
14. How much time do we have for lunch? 20 minutes to eat
15. How many elementary schools go to Goff? There are 5 district elementary schools
16. Will other 6th grade teams have the same lunch? You will typically eat lunch with your team only
17. What kind of food is available in the lunchroom? Ice cream, breadsticks, hot pretzels, hot lunch, sandwiches, taco salad, etc...
18. What subjects will we take? Math, Science, Social Studies, English, Art, Technology, PE, Home and Careers

19. Can students walk to school? Yes, with parents permission
20. How much bullying takes place at school? Bullying may happen and the middle school is very proactive in dealing with bullying. Your school counselors will meet with each class in the beginning of the year to discuss this topic.
21. Where should you go when you first walk into Goff? Locker and then homeroom
22. What will you play in PE? You name it you play it! In Physical Education you could play football, run track, dance, play volleyball, speed ball etc...
