Dear Parents/Guardians:

The next Goff School Activity Night is the PE Sports Club Pajama Holiday Activity Movie Night scheduled for **Saturday**, December 1, 2018, for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th graders who have exhibited good behavior at school. The cost to each student is \$5.00.

Wristbands are used for entry instead of tickets. The price of the wristband is \$5.00 and will be sold **only** on Friday, November 30th, during your child's lunch period. In order to purchase a wristband, your child must have a signed permission slip and no significant discipline referrals to the office. Permission slips will be given in school but, will also be available online on the Goff School website. **Students must bring the signed permission slip in with them on Friday, November 30th along with \$5.00.** When your child purchases a wristband, it will be placed on their wrist. Wristbands will not be sold at the door. Refreshments may be purchased. **Please send your child in with small bills.**

The Goff Pajama Holiday Activity Movie Night will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the Goff gymnasium. Students should be dropped off between 6:00 and 6:20 p.m. Any student entering after 6:20 p.m. **MUST** have their parents escort them to the door. **No** students should be brought to the Holiday Pajama Movie Night before 6:00 p.m. Each student is expected to remain the entire time until **9:00 p.m.** Parents are responsible for providing transportation home from the school promptly at 9:00 p.m. Students may not walk home.

We are interested in making this event enjoyable for your children. In order to help us, please review the following guidelines with your child. Any student who does not follow the Guidelines for Student Behavior, or is disorderly, will be expelled from the Movie Night. A parent will be contacted to provide immediate transportation home.

*GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL DANCES AND ACTIVITY NIGHTS*

1. If a student is absent from school on the day of the movie, they will not be allowed to attend the movie.
2. Possession of cigarettes or smoking in the building or on school grounds is prohibited.
3. Embracing, kissing and similar behaviors are prohibited.
3. Pushing, shoving and moshing are inappropriate behaviors and are prohibited. Mini glow sticks are also prohibited at the Movie Night.
4. Those who attend must wear pajamas in according with our holiday theme. No pajamas, no entry. The parents of a student who is dressed improperly will be called and the student may be asked to leave.
6. Anyone known to be in possession of, or using, alcoholic beverages or drugs will not be admitted. Anyone known to be in possession of, or using, alcoholic beverages or drugs on school property will be dealt with according to Board of Education policy.
7. All chaperones are supervisors. All students will obey the directions given by chaperones.
