

Why Review Elementary Attendance Zones?

- Equitable Educational Experiences For Students
- Board Commitment To The Neighborhood School Concept
- Promote Efficient Use Of Existing Building Spaces
- SED Does Not Fund New Building Additions When Space Exists In Other Buildings
- Attendance Boundaries Should Be Contiguous To The Extent Possible
- Changes Should Have The Least Disruption For Students & Families

Key Points

- Bell Top Elementary School Will Be Overcrowded Absent Taking Any Action
 - Current sections range from 19 to 27 students
 - 2019-2020 Kindergarten enrollments are expected to be about 8% to 10% higher than this year
 - Space is not available for new class sections
 - A short-term plan is needed





- No Impact To Existing Elementary Students
 - Students who currently attend any elementary school at any grade may continue to attend that school in 2019-2020, along with their newly enrolled siblings



- No Impact To Siblings
 - Siblings of students currently attending elementary schools may enroll there in 2018-2019 and 2019-2020



- Bell Top Border Zone Neighborhoods Will Be Redesignated To Red Mill Or Citizen Genet Elementary Schools
 - For newly enrolled grades K-5 students this school year (2018-2019)
 - For newly enrolled students grades K-5 next school year (2019-2020)
 - For students entering Kindergarten in 2019-2020



 Red Mill And Citizen Genet Schools Have Sufficient Capacity To Absorb Additional Students



- The Center for Therapeutic Academic Excellence
 Program (CTAEP) at Bell Top will move to Citizen Genet in September 2019, freeing up 3 classrooms for student sections
- Other building space options not desirable for immediate implementation or which require additional consideration/time



- The Attendance Zones Must Be Revisited During The 2019-2020 School Year
 - Review actual enrollments and class sections
 - Work with CASDA consultant and the Budget Review & Advisory Committee on housing growth and impact on enrollment
