Review sessions are held in the South Forum. Late bus passes, if needed, will be handed out at the end of the session. These sessions are voluntary.

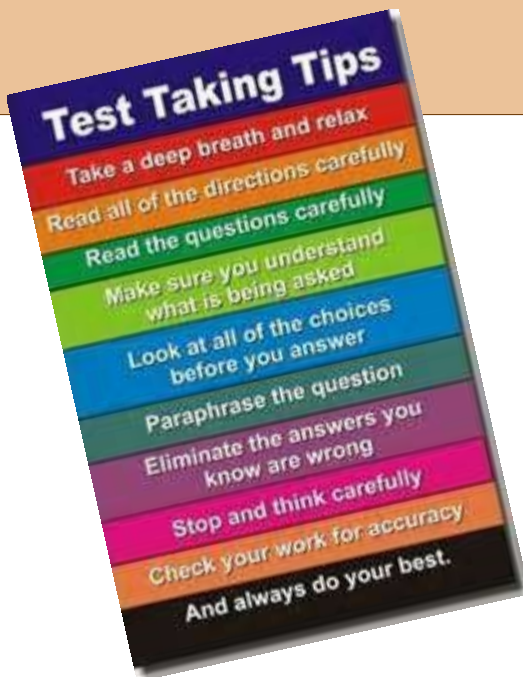

EXAM GUIDELINES

All candidates for Regents/Common Core Exams are to be in the testing area and rooms at 7:30 a.m. for their morning exams and at 11:30 a.m. for the afternoon exams.

Regents/Common Core Exams will begin at 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Students may not leave the testing site before 10:00 and 2:00, respectively.

The cafeteria (breakfast) will be open from 7:00am to 10:00am. (See specific schedule on page 2)

****ELECTRONICS POLICY**-- cell phones are not permitted in any testing site at any time during a Regents examination. If a student is found to be using a cell phone, including simply looking at it during an exam, the cell phone is to be confiscated. The student may be removed from the testing site and the student's test may be destroyed.**

CHS Transportation for the Regents Exam schedule is as follows:

- ◆ Beginning Tuesday, June 18th, regular morning buses will be running to get students taking the exam(s) to school
- ◆ There will be an 11:15 dismissal using the six late run buses (the bus routes will be posted on the District web page prior to the exam dates)
- ◆ There will be a 2:03 regular run, and the 2:25 shuttle from CHS to Goff to take the regular Goff Dismissal bus home. Please verify with posting on web page closer to Regents week for final confirmation of dates/times.



ATTENDANCE TRACKING INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS:

There is an APP that will inform parents immediately of **each class period** when their student has been marked as absent at Columbia High.

On your phone (if not reached via clicking on link on front page):

1. Go to the APP STORE
2. Do a search for "Powerschool Mobile".
3. Once downloaded, you must enable "Push Notification" in your phone settings.
4. A text will be sent to your phone for each missed class period marked on our PowerSchool program.
5. School code is: BRCT

As well, we have the PowerSchool's Parent Portal where parents can follow their child's attendance and grades.

On your computer (if not reached via clicking on link on front page):

1. Type in "EGCSD.org" to bring up the district webpage
2. On the top Blue line, click on "PowerSchool"
3. Click on Students/Parents
4. In the Sign-In box that comes up, either sign in or create an account.
