

Hi Jets families!

I am writing to share some information regarding the upcoming CD Jets Ice Hockey season!

There you can find the practice and game schedule (thanks Cindy!). During the season we will keep the site updated with stats and team standings.

IMPORTANT NEWS! We are looking to fill our 5th board position. The focus of this position will be school community connection. We are looking for someone to connect with our 5 High Schools, increase our student fan base, find students to sing the national anthem at home games, find someone to play music at home games and to organize Teacher Appreciation Night. Please let me know if this position is something you would be interested in. This is a voting position on the board.

We are also looking for a sibling of a player (16 and above) to video our home games. This is a paid position - \$20 per game, and training will be provided. Please send a note to me if you know someone who is interested.

Parent Information Night will be Wednesday October 23rd at 7:00, Shaker High School Cafeteria. Come out to meet the coaches and ask questions. Players and parents welcomed!

Please ensure your player has their school physical up to date in order to be ready for tryouts. Tryouts are intended for students in 9th-12th grade. Any 8th grader interested in trying out will need to contact Coach Rock to see if they are eligible for the Athletic Placement Process.

Practice times: Beginning November 18th - Mondays - the team will have strength and conditioning at Shaker High School 4-6.

In general - on ice practices will be Tuesday and Thursday at Albany County Hockey Facility from 4:30 to 5:40, and Wednesdays at Frear Park 4:30-5:50. BUT please see the team website for the practice schedule as it does vary.

Uniforms: The 5 schools have purchased new uniforms for the team this season and they look great! We will have home and away jerseys proudly displaying the CD Jets logo. Players will also receive game and practice socks and Jets shells. These are at no cost to the players. Our awesome schools also purchased new practice jerseys for the team.

Equipment: New players to the program will receive a JETS helmet and an equipment bag with the players name embroidered. Any returning players wishing to purchase a replacement for these items can place their order with the board but will be at player's cost.

JETS bling: An online store will be up and running shortly where players can purchase the kits required for the team. Optional JETS wearables will also be available. More information will be coming once the store is set up.

Player Assessments: We worked very hard to keep the player assessment fees low. The booster club is tasked with paying for ice time, new player helmets and bags, game filming and analysis, teambuilding activities and special nights like senior night. Player assessments cover those costs. This year, depending on how many players are selected, all Varsity Players will be assessed a fee between \$1240-\$1300. Practice Players will be assessed a fee of \$500. **Please note - if your child is selected as a Varsity Player or Practice Player - you will need to provide a check on November 15 for the full player assessment amount in order to accept the position on the team. Checks should be payable to "Friends of CD Jets Ice Hockey".**

CD Jets Program: Similar to previous years all players can sell advertisements or puck notes to be placed in the Jets Program in order to reduce their assessment. I have attached the forms for your use. All advertisements MUST be

provided by November 22! Anything received after that date cannot be included as we will need to go to print. For any advertisement or puck note check received **before November 22**, the player will receive a refund from the Booster Club. Any checks received before **November 15** will be applied directly to lower your assessment.

As a cost savings to the team and a show of community support, the Averill Park High School Graphic Design teacher has offered to include some of the design work for the JETS Program in his curriculum. An AP alumni and graduate of St. Rose, Gina Lincoln, will help finalize the program pro-bono! She will have an ad in the program - please support her business for any design/logo needs.

Also - we seem to have quite a few left over programs from previous years. If you would like any, let me know. Otherwise they will be recycled. The ones from last year will be available at Parent Information Night.

Transportation: Families are responsible for getting your players to and from practices, work out sessions, home games and some away games. South Colonie will provide bus transportation to games north and west of the Albany County Hockey Facility. More information will come regarding which games the players will ride the bus and what times players will need to arrive.

Game themes: This year in addition to Senior night (February 1st) we will have a Teacher Appreciation Night (December 14th) and CD Jets Fight T1D (Type 1 Diabetes) (January 25th). More information will be forthcoming on those nights!

Home game help: Each hockey family will need to cover 5 time slots for various duties at home games (clock, penalty box, 50/50, admissions, etc). Signups sheets will be available on November 15th.

We are all excited for the upcoming season! Let's go JETS!!
