 - Family and Community Impact


School Start Time Survey



- Three separate surveys open December 3-21, 2018
 - K-12 Parents (1,127 responses)
 - Columbia High School students (319 responses)
 - East Greenbush CSD staff (263 responses)
- Survey addressed the impact on various topics
 - Start/Dismissal times for K-5, 6-8 and 9-12
 - Busing Routes
 - Athletics and Clubs/Activities
 - Childcare
 - School District Budget
 - K-12 Instructional Program

Later High School Start Time






Later Middle School Start Time


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
Later Elementary School Start Time

Potential Benefits of Earlier Elementary Start Time



- Younger Students are Up Earlier
- Morning Provides "Prime Time" for Core Instruction
- Students with Later Lunches Seem Tired in the Afternoon
- After-School Enrichment Clubs
- Limited Study/Inconclusive Research




- Start Times and Locations for Games and Practices
- Coordination with Other Suburban Council Districts
- Travel Distances (Saratoga, Burnt Hills, Ballston Spa)
- Impact of Later Dismissal Times on Game/Club/Work Start Times
- Later Return Times, Homework, Bedtimes
- High School and Middle School Before School Options/Elementary After-School Options
- Before School Options, Survey Split-⅓ Positive, ⅓ Negative, ⅓ Unsure

Busing



- One of the Biggest Factors in Considering a Change to School Start Times
 - 76.6 Square Miles
 - 4,500 Students
 - 50 locations (District Schools, Private/Parochial/Charters, Special Education, McKinney-Vento)
 - 85 Buses on Road/Day, 103 in Fleet, Inspection and Maintenance Requirements



Busing Questions



 Can the school district SAFELY and COST EFFECTIVELY reorganize its busing system to support alternatives which will facilitate a later school start time for CHS?

Can a change in the busing system be made without impacting other schools

within the district?



Two-Tiered vs. Three-Tiered System



- Consultant's Report
 - Two-Tiered System
 - Increases the Number of Buses Required
 - Increases the Number of Students on Buses (crowded)
 - Increases Length of Bus Routes and Ride Times for Students
- Survey
 - 68.6% of parents surveyed are either unsure or feel combining middle school students with high school students on buses would have a negative impact
 - 55.2% of parents surveyed feel that elementary students riding the same buses with middle school students would likely have a negative impact
- Considering all factors, the district needs to maintain a three-tiered busing system

Impact on Childcare



- More than 90% of parents surveyed said they do not rely on their high school age children to provide after-school supervision to their elementary age or middle school age children.
- 52% of parents surveyed said they were UNSURE if an earlier start and dismissal time at the elementary school level would have a positive or negative impact on their before or after school childcare arrangements.

- District Lease Agreement with Greenbush Childcare
- Programs in Each School, K-8
- Flexibility to Adjust Times
- Driven By Enrollment and Staffing

Impact on School Budget/Operations



- State Aid Trends-Revenue Shortfalls
- Property Tax Cap
- Bus Reserve Funds Used for Planned Bus Purchases, Increases Budget and No Drivers Available
- Finite Resources: Remember if We Put Something Into the Budget, Something Has to Come Out
- Survey: "Don't Do it, If It Reduces Programs for Kids!"
- 40.9% of Parents: Change in School Start/Dismissal Times Not Worth Additional Tax Increases
- 48.3% of Staff: Change in School Start/Dismissal Times Not Worth Additional Tax Increases
