Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Goff School Holiday Pajama Movie Night is scheduled for Saturday, December 7, 2019, for 6th, 7th, and 8th graders who have exhibited good behavior at school. The cost to each student is \$5.00. Students can bring a blanket, come in their PJs and enjoy a movie in the Gym. Students should bring additional money for snacks, pizza, and candy.

Wristbands are used for entry instead of tickets. The price of the wristband is \$5.00 and will be sold **only** on Friday, December 7th, during your child's lunch period. In order to purchase a wristband, your child must have a signed permission slip and no significant discipline referrals to the office. Permission slips will be given in school but will also be available online on the Goff School website. **Students must bring a signed permission slip in with them on Friday.** When your child purchases a wristband, it will be placed on their wrist. When they enter the event, the wristband will be removed by a chaperone. Wristbands will not be sold at the door. Refreshments may be purchased. **Please send your child in with small bills.**

The Goff Holiday Pajama Movie Night will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in the Goff gym. Students should be dropped off at 6:00 p.m. Any student entering after 6:15 p.m. **MUST** have their parents escort them to the door. **No** students should be brought to the event before 6:00 p.m. Each student is expected to remain the entire time until **8:00 p.m.** At the end of the announced time, parents are responsible for providing transportation home from the school. Students may not walk home.

We are interested in making this event enjoyable for your children. In order to help us, please review the following guidelines with your child. Any student who does not follow the guidelines for student behavior, or is disorderly, will be removed from the event. A parent will be contacted to provide immediate transportation home.

We hope you share our expectations of your child's behavior while at the Goff Holiday Pajama Movie Night. Please sign and return the permission slip (on the back of this page) to school in order for your child to purchase a wristband.

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL DANCES AND ACTIVITY NIGHTS

1. If a student is absent from school on the day of the dance, they will not be allowed to attend the movie night.
2. Possession of cigarettes or smoking in the building or on school grounds is prohibited.
3. Embracing, kissing and similar behaviors are prohibited.
4. Pushing, shoving and moshing are inappropriate behaviors and are prohibited. Mini glow sticks are also prohibited at the movie night.
5. Those who attend should be dressed in pajamas that are appropriate. If a student is wearing improper attire a parent will be called and the student may be asked to leave.
6. Anyone known to be in possession of, or using, alcoholic beverages or drugs will not be admitted. Anyone known to be in possession of, or using, alcoholic beverages or drugs on school property will be dealt with according to Board of Education policy.
7. All chaperones are supervisors. All students will obey the directions given by chaperones.
