


Shaker Athletics Host Protocol

Equipment (to be brought by visiting team):

Soccer: Visiting team is responsible for bringing all supplies for warm up.

Field Hockey: Visiting team is responsible for bringing all supplies for warm up.

Tennis: Balls will be supplied by Shaker.

Swimming: Counters will be supplied by Shaker.

Golf: Visiting team is responsible for all equipment used to compete.

Water availability:

It is the responsibility of guest teams to bring their own water.

Bench area seating:

Seating is identified by dots on benches (indicating social distance of 6 feet per athlete); all other athletes on the sideline who are standing still must maintain appropriate distancing and mask wearing.

Trainer availability:

The general athletic trainer hours are from 4-6:00, with additional hours for home contests. Trainers are centrally located in the concession building north of Walker Field; they can also be reached by phone.

Locker room availability/bathroom resources:

With the exception of Swimming & Diving, locker room access will NOT be available during contests. For all contests on Walker Field, Front Field, or Hill Field, athletes and spectators will have access to bathrooms in the concession building directly north of the field. Contest played on Upper Maloy or Lower Maloy will have access to bathrooms on the East side of the building; athletic safety coordinators will be on location to provide building access. Contest played on Blue Creek Field will have access to bathrooms in the J Wing of the high school building; athletic safety coordinators will be on location to provide building access.

Emergency action plans:

In the event of an emergency, the host coach will contact: Athletic Director Matt Stein, Custodial Office, Athletic Safety Coordinators, Athletic Trainer/First Aider. If warranted, the host coach will also call 911.

Spectator protocol:For spectators, the following additional safety measures apply:

- Spectators will be limited to two per player. Spectators must wear a specified “spectator” badge. Appropriate gathering size and guidelines will be listed on each badge.
- Spectators must maintain six feet of physical distance between individuals and/or family/household units at all times and all spectators must wear face coverings when they are in common areas and situations where six feet of distancing is not able to be maintained, so long as they are over the age of two and medically able to tolerate such covering.
- Spectators will be asked their name and phone number for the purpose of potential contact tracing.
- **Tennis:** Due to space and safety restrictions, no spectators will be allowed in the alleyway for home matches.
- **Swimming & Diving:** Due to space and safety restrictions, no spectators will be allowed for all Suburban Council meets..
- Athletic safety coordinators will facilitate appropriate distancing through the use of markings on the ground or seating areas, and other signage.
 - Athletic safety coordinators will ensure that, among all spectators, no individual group exceeds the gathering limit that is currently in place for the region.
