8. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Code of Conduct 2021- 2022

Ms. Cannon provided potential updates to the Code of Conduct for the 2021-2022 school year

- The Global Awareness Committee would like to add the word "inclusiveness" to the expectations in the introduction section.
- The School Resource Officer has advised that chemical agents, air guns and automatic guns be added to the weapon description.
- The Global Awareness Committee has asked to add "Be inclusive and collaborative" to the student's responsibilities section.
- A revision to the dress code to allow students to wear items that reflect religious or cultural beliefs.
- An addition of a section called Safety and Health, which would require all staff, students and visitors to follow pandemic and/or communicable disease protocols.
- Under behavioral expectations for grades 9-12, the committee suggests splitting a current violation, to make parking without a permit and reckless driving on school grounds into two separate violations with separate consequences.
- Also, under behavioral expectations for grades 9-12, the committee suggests splitting the violation regarding the possession, use and distribution of tobacco products into two separate violations. One being possession and use and the other being distribution, each with their own consequences.
- Under behavioral expectations for grades K-12, add language to reference the student dress code on page 9.
- In the behavioral expectations section, update the violation, possession of a weapon, to reflect the modified description of a weapon

Ms. Cannon asked the Board to review the changes. She also opened it up for public comment. She stated if there are no comments, the Code of Conduct will be included on the next meeting agenda for Board approval.

B. Updates for Planning for Fall 2021 / New York State Guidance

Mr. Simons reported that at this time, New York State school districts have not received any guidance from the New York State Education Department, the New York State Department of Health nor the Governor's Office about the fall re-opening.

He stated that he hopes schools will fully reopen in the fall, but will keep everyone updated on the guidance as it becomes available.

C. Status of Pre-K Planning

Mr. Simons discussed the plan for using the \$583,000 federal grant for a Universal Pre-K program. He explained that it was determined that the most reasonable and effective way to provide Pre-K would be in collaboration with a community-based provider by request for proposals. He stated the RFP's were sent out, and only one agency that could serve approximately 30-40 students responded. The Superintendent reported that feedback suggested the low response was due to the shortage of childcare workers, the short turnaround time to respond, and the limited amount of money allotted per child. He explained that the \$5400 per child is lower than the actual cost for the agencies to run their programs. Mr. Simons stated he has reached out to Questar BOCES for an alternative program, in addition to possibly awarding the RFP. He explained a Questar program would need to be located within the District, and said that there would be room for two classes at Red Mill. He reported costs could possibly be offset by monies available through the American Rescue Plan, but said the Preschool Committee will continue to work on this proposal, and will bring it back to the Board at a future meeting.
