#### 6. PUBLIC FORUM #1

Ms. Catherine <u>Von Orden</u>, parent of students at Genet and Goff, expressed her disappointment in the lack of a remote option. She asked Mr. Simons and the Board to address her many concerns about reopening, including the reduction of six-foot distancing in band and chorus and the possibility of implementing tents for cafeterias in good weather.

### 7. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS - SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

A. Presentation of School Opening Plan

Mr. <u>Simons</u> discussed how the increasing infection rates in Rensselaer County, and the transition to Governor Hochul, have made the reopening plan evolve.

He announced multi-layered mitigation strategies to maintain a healthy and safe environment:

- Temperature checks
- Universal masking regardless of vaccination status
- Social distancing
- Regular cleaning and disinfection
- Respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene
- · Parents/guardians and staff screen for symptoms each day
- · Students and staff staying home when sick
- Surveillance testing

Mr. Simons discussed:

<u>Ventilation:</u> having purge cycle programs in all the schools to bring in fresh air, repaired and replaced exhaust fans and running them 24/7, and upgraded air filters and changing them on a regular basis.

Cleaning & Disinfection: Continued and regular cleaning & disinfecting of school buildings, buses and high touch areas.

<u>Transportation:</u> all students and staff must wear face masks, windows and roof hatches will be kept open, cleaning and disinfection of buses will continue daily.

<u>Cafeteria:</u> Seating arrangements to ensure physical distancing, hand-washing or sanitizing before and after meals, limited mask removal during eating, cleaning and disinfection between lunch periods, and increased ventilation of seating areas.

<u>Athletics:</u> Mandatory surveillance testing for higher risk sports, voluntary surveillance testing for moderate to low-risk sports, contact tracing information required through use of a QR code and app, and continued face mask requirements.

<u>Music:</u> Masks required for general music, chorus, and orchestra, and students will maintain a three-foot social distancing. Students playing wind instruments will also maintain three feet distancing and make use of bell covers for the instruments. Outdoor instruction will be considered as weather permits.

<u>Physical Education classes:</u> Six feet distancing will be maintained, masks will continue to be required. Teachers will prioritize activities as weather permits.

The Superintendent also described school procedures for all the schools and contact tracing protocols.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> reported a full remote option will be available through Questar III BOCES for students who are medically eligible. He stated the application must be submitted by August 27, 2021 to be reviewed by the school physician, so eligibility can be determined.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> stated that COVID-19 updates will be shared with faculty, staff, and families via email and text message and that opening plans will be posted on the District website.

## B. Fall Athletics - High Risk Sports

Mr. <u>Simons</u> explained the CDC recommendations on high-risk sports and reported the District would be implementing a mandatory testing program for the Athletes who play high-risk sports, such as football, volleyball, and cheer, prior to sports practices and games. He explained a QR Code app, that enlists an attestation form, will help keep track of attendance of the spectators and will aid if contact tracing is necessary.

#### 8. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Universal Pre-K

Ms. <u>Wager</u> stated that because the District works closely with Questar and is always happy with their programs and staff, she was recommending an agreement with them to provide two Pre-K classes at Red Mill for the 2021-2022 school year. She stated the program would cost more than the amount of the federal funds provided, but the costs of a Pre-K program are an allowable expense in the ARP grant. Ms. <u>Wager</u> explained there is an application process for families to enroll their child, but since enrollment would be limited to 36 students, the District would plan a live-streamed event to choose the random applicants.

#### B. Federal Fund Applications - CRRSA and ARP

Ms. <u>Wager</u> presented the CRRSA and ARP applications and went over how the money was allocated. She stated she has already submitted the CRRSA application, and hopes to submit the ARP application on August 26, 2021.
