# 8. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. School Update

Mr. <u>Simons</u> acknowledged all the work the staff has done not only to meet the protocols, but to try to bring normalcy back into classroom and extracurricular activities. He reported the Early Intervention program is up and running and students are receiving services in reading and math. He reported this is the first time in many years the District is using data to determine staffing in the buildings with the help of the Renaissance assessments. The Superintendent discussed the Learning Resource Center at Columbia High School and stated that the additional staff has been added. He said the LRC is being used primarily for math but is also available for English help.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> also spoke of some of the challenges, such as quarantining protocols that are affecting the students' ability to attend inperson learning. He reported that area counties and other districts are discussing the possibility of modifying some of the quarantine requirements. He said one of the requirements being discussed is shortening the quarantine period from ten days to seven days, or to permit students to return to school if they test every day. He also stated they are looking into advocating to reduce the distancing requirement for contact tracing on the buses.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> reported the Covid-19 testing may not begin until late Oct or early Nov. He said Questar is still waiting for the supplies, antigen tests and machines that do the point of care testing. He said a consent form will be sent home to assess interest in student testing, so the District can prepare.

The Superintendent also announced the upcoming special event to celebrate Green Meadow earning National recognition as a Blue Ribbon School.

#### B. Pre-K Planning Update

Ms. <u>Wager</u> reported on the October 5, 2021, lottery selection for the Universal Pre-K program. She stated there were 98 applicants with one withdrawal. She thanked Michael Wolff, the District's internal auditor for his assistance. She also thanked Helen Squillace, Jeanne Pangburn, Stephanie Jorgensen, Peter Goodwin and Wayne Morrow for their help. She reported the selected families were contacted and are in the process of registration. Ms. <u>Wager</u> stated that Questar has hired two teachers and two teacher assistants

for the program, and they are all available to start on October 12th. She said all the furniture and supplies have been ordered, and it looks like the program would be ready to begin on October 18, 2021.
