7. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS - SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

A. Utica National Insurance Group - "School Safety Excellence Award" for 2021 - Superintendent Jeffrey Simons

Mr. <u>Simons</u> was happy to report that the District has received the "School Safety Excellence Award", for the 18th consecutive year. He stated the award was to recognize the District has had few accidents, incidents and claims. He congratulated the Board and entire staff on this accomplishment.

Mr. <u>Buono</u> said he appreciated all the work the staff has done to make East Greenbush Central School District a safe working and learning environment.

B. Winter Interscholastic Sports Registrations/Vaccination Status

Mr. <u>Simons</u> updated the Board and the community on the vaccination status of the students registered to play high risk sports. He stated that most have complied with the mandate or are in the process of vaccination. He said students that have recently become age eligible at the modified level will still be able to register as long as he/she begins the vaccination process as soon as they can.

C. Tutoring Update Memo to Superintendent Simons

Mr. <u>McHugh</u> presented an update on the tutoring occurring within the District. He said that the District has provided 546.5 hours of tutoring with the majority for the grades K-5, assisting students that have been quarantined due to COVID-19. He stated students in grades 6-12, receive tutoring for medical reasons, academic intervention and in-school and out-of-school suspensions. Mr. <u>McHugh</u> reported there has been approximately 40 additional hours a month of tutoring than in a normal non-COVID year.

8. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Winter Interscholastic Sports/Concerts - Spectators

Mr. <u>Simons</u> explained the District will be allowing up to four family members for each student to attend athletic competitions in-person. He said there will also be an area of the gym reserved for approximately 100 student spectators.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> discussed that at the middle and high school level concerts will be held in the Columbia High School auditorium. He stated that approximately 400 people would be able to attend while observing social distancing guidelines. He said performances at each grade level will be staggered, giving time between for one grade to leave and another to enter. The Superintendent explained that the elementary music departments have decided to wait until spring to have their concerts.

Mr. Simons reported that both athletic games and concerts will be broadcast for people to watch remotely at no cost.

B. Board Goals and Strategic Priorities

Mr. Simons presented the first draft of the Goals and Strategic Priorities the District will strive to attain this school year.

Mr. Mann stated he would like to review the goals and would like to have the ability to suggest changes at a later time.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> said that this was the first draft, and just wanted to present this to the Board. He said he is not asking the Board to vote on the goals at this time.

Mr. <u>Buono</u> asked the Board to review the goals and let him or Mr. Simons know of any changes they would like to see, to fine tune the goals to fit the 2021-2022 school year.

A. Marissa Cannon, Director of Human Resources - Staffing Update

Ms. Cannon gave an update on open positions throughout the District and shared where they are in the hiring process.

B. Linda Wager, Director of Business and Finance BRAC/ Long Range Planning Committee Meeting Minutes of October 18, 2021-Advocacy Committee Meeting Minutes of October 27, 2021

Ms. <u>Wager</u> gave an overview of the recent BRAC/ Long Range Planning Committee Meeting and stated Mr. Bickel gave a presentation showing items that have been completed in the current capital project. She said he also provided a list of items under consideration in the Building Condition Survey. She said the District is working with MARCH Associates on the Building Conditions Survey and will provide a priority list and estimated budget, which will be filed in 2022.

Ms. <u>Wager</u> also spoke of the Advocacy Committee meeting. She said she was happy to report there are five students participating. She said they talked about COVID-19 and how quarantine is affecting the District, and also talked about finance and the relationship between budget, tax levy and state aid.

C. James McHugh, Asst. Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction None at this time.

D. Jeffrey Simons, Superintendent - Health and Safety Committee Meeting Minutes of Oct. 25, 2021

Mr. <u>Simons</u> said the Health and Safety Committee discussed technology that is available to detect vaping. He said a guest from Altech Innovations presented information on the Halo system that not only detects vaping, but also can detect noises and other behaviors. Mr. <u>Simons</u> stated Mohanasen CSD has purchased this technology and administrators may visit to see how that technology is working out. He said the District is just exploring this technology at this time.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> reported that over the summer, Questar provided a training focused on safety response and crisis intervention for students, He said the District's team gave an overview of the training and reported that some materials and information would be helpful to the safety teams. The Superintendent stated he has invited all local law enforcement agencies to come to the next meeting to discuss the District's safety plans.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> acknowledged the TikTok videos promoting vandalism and other behaviors. He stated there were incidents at the start of the year, but it has diminished, and the situation is being monitored. Mr. <u>Simons</u> also reported that the District is inspecting the elementary playgrounds, and Mr. Bickel is putting together a report for the Board on the playground needs and the cost of fixing or replacing the playground equipment.
