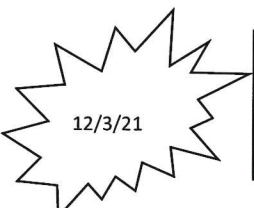
R This coming week will be a "B Week" for Genet.
