2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

3. EX OFFICIO STUDENT COUNCIL COMMENTS AND PRESENTATIONS

A. Student Council Representatives: Ryan Seely-President; Emma Marchiony-Vice President

Ryan Seely said the ice cream fundraiser benefiting Columbia Kicks Cancer has been postponed to Friday, February 11, 2022 due to the impending snow storm. Emma Marchiony reported that Student Council has voted to donate \$300 to the Mary Lally Education Fund, a scholarship in memory of Mrs. Lally, that will benefit one of her Life Skills students.

5. BOARD FORUM #1

Ms. O'Brien expressed her sympathies to the family and friends of Tyler Lopresti-Castro, a 2019 graduate who recently passed away.

6. PUBLIC FORUM #1

Mr. Michael Seney asked for clarity on if the mask mandate was to be deemed unconstitutional would the District and Board remove the requirement. He also asked Mr. Simons to explain what he meant at the last meeting when he said something to the effect that the District needs to do more with the athletic classes because there has been an uptick in myocarditis amongst unvaccinated students.

Mr. Benjamin Kissel asked if anyone could show him the actual law the District was following. He also expressed his concerns about the budget and asked if there was a cap on spending. He reminded the Board that not everyone agrees with the vaccine mandate and urged the Board to be fair to all families in the district when making decisions. Mr. Kissel also asked about the take home tests, and was concerned about the costs of providing them.

Mr. Jeremy Shuhart stated he has looked back at past Board meetings and thanked Mr. Buono and Mr. Mann for being a voice for people who do not agree with the vaccine mandate. He reiterated that parents should have the right to decide what is right for their own children. Mr. Shuhart asked how the District would respond if the mandate was lifted, and what the process would be.

Mr Simons and Mr. Buono said they will respond to the concerns by email. Mr. Buono also discussed the budget process and invited the community to attend meetings if they were concerned about the costs, or for just more information.

7. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS - SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

A. Reports and Presentations - Superintendent of Schools

B. OSC Audit Report- Leave Accruals

Mr. Simons explained that as part of their oversight responsibilities, the Comptroller's office will regularly audit school districts and local municipalities. He gave an overview of the process and stated that after looking at the overall management of the business office, the Comptroller's Office chooses an area to do a more detailed audit. He explained that in East Greenbush's audit, the OSC decided to look at the leave accruals for staff, making sure it is being calculated in accordance with the contracts, and in the case of staff being eligible for payouts for leave time, that it was handled correctly. Mr. Simons reported that 30 samples were pulled for audit and zero issues were found and a favorable report was given to the District.

8. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. ENL Program Restructuring

Mr. McHugh discussed the ENL program and said with the increasing enrollment the District would like to expand the program and add a cluster at Red Mill. He stated that Red Mill was chosen because many ENL families reside in the Red Mill attendance zone.

Mr. Grignon explained the challenges of the expanding enrollment and integrating the students into classrooms. He explained if the ENL population gets too large the students do not receive the language immersion necessary.

Mr. Buono asked Ms. Squillace if she felt there would be enough space at Red Mill.

Ms. Squillace expressed her excitement of working with the ENL students. She said she felt there would be space, especially if Pre-K opportunities were spread to other elementary schools in the District. She also stated that a large amount of the students reside in the Red Mill zone, and many parents would like their children to attend school with the other children in their neighborhoods.

B. Budget Information, Enrollment, Projected Class Sections-Elementary

Mr. Simons gave an explanation of the State's distribution of Foundation Aid and reported that a three year phase-in will bring the aid up to where the formula says the District should receive. The Superintendent also gave a projection of the District's enrollment for next year, and stated the District uses this information to determine the staffing needs at each school.

C. Any Updates-COVID Protocols

Mr. Simons discussed the at-home test protocols, for students who are unvaccinated and might be subject to quarantine if exposed to a case. He also explained the District is no longer requiring temperature checks at the entry points, and the staff has been reassigned to other responsibilities within the schools.

Mr. Buono reminded the community that COVID-19 updates are on the website, and stated he was happy to see a decline in cases in the last few days.
