5. BOARD FORUM #1

Mr. <u>Yeboah</u> thanked the community, the Board and the Administrators for the opportunity to serve on the Board of Education, and said he hopes to return to serve again sometime in the future.

Mr. Buono thanked Mr. Yeboah for his service and said he hopes to see him back.

6. PUBLIC FORUM #1

7. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS - SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

A. Alternate Education Program Review

Mr. <u>McHugh</u> explained the Alternate Education Program, discussed how the program has evolved, and highlighted the goals.

Mr. <u>Marsh</u> thanked the Board, Administrators and the community for their support of the program.

Mr. Buono asked if students were able to transition out of the program and if Mr. Marsh followed the students after graduation.

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Mr. <u>Marsh</u> stated that some students transition out, and he tries to keep up with all the students, just not in a formal way. He said that over the course of the four years, he and the other staff forge very strong relationships with the CAP students and they do continue to keep in touch after graduation. Mr. <u>Marsh</u> invited the Board to visit the CAP classrooms and talk with the students anytime, to get a better understanding of the program.

B. Reports and Presentations-2022-2025 Technology Plan-Peter Goodwin

Mr. <u>Goodwin</u> gave a presentation highlighting the goals for the next 4 years for the Technology Department. He explained how the goals of the program align with the District scorecard and the New York State Education Department.

Mr. <u>Buono</u> asked if the student help desk workers receive college credit for their work.

Mr. <u>Goodwin</u> said there is a program through the Business department, where the students can do an internship right at the school for credit.

Mr. Buono said he would like to see some of the students from the help desk come to a future meeting.

Ms. <u>Curtin</u> thanked Mr. Goodwin for pointing out that the technology used with the ENL students should be available and shared with all teachers, not just the ENL teachers. She also discussed testing software and suggested the Technology Department look into the ExamSoft program, a non-cloud based program.

Mr. Goodwin said the District has begun using Renaissance Star for testing this year, but will look into ExamSoft, as well.

8. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Reflection and Celebration of the School Year

Mr. Buono asked the School Administrators for reflection and highlights of this school year:

Overall, the Administrators all said the biggest highlight was the removal of the mask mandate. They all reported a big difference in morale when everyone could see smiles and face reactions, again. The Administrators also shared stories of field trips, concerts, athletic activities, moving up ceremonies, graduation etc, but basically stated that it was nice to just get back to normal after the long pandemic.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> thanked all the Administrators for doing everything they could to make the best of a difficult situation throughout the pandemic. He stated his appreciation, not only for keeping the District open, but by also making the District better by working together to find solutions. He also thanked the Board for their support, and their focus on the students.

Ms. <u>O'Brien</u> thanked the Administrators for staying on course the last couple of years throughout all the challenges and changes, and said she and other parents are very thankful and appreciative that the District was able to bring some of the events back this year.

B. New York State Reporting Requirements- Foundation Aid and ARP

Ms. <u>Wager</u> explained the new requirement for reporting for schools that earned more than 10% in aid. She said East Greenbush received an 11% increase, and she will be filing a report by July 1, 2022, showing how the funds will be used, such as: to purchase additional APEX licenses, new textbooks to align with the standards, the Renaissance Star Assessment program for the K-8 level, additional resources for ENL and special education students, and adding additional staff to support all the new programs. Ms. <u>Wager</u> explained the need to show community involvement and stated that Mr. Adam regularly posts stories on the website and monitors the Facebook accounts. She stated she will also be reporting about parent participation on the Committee for Curriculum Studies and the Education Committee.
