Mr. <u>Dunn</u> welcomed Ms. Steinbach and Mr. Stiles to the team and wished them luck in their new positions. Mr. <u>Mann</u> also welcomed them both, and said he was looking forward to working with them this year. Ms. Steinbach thanked everyone for the warm welcome.

5. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS - SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

A. Proposed Change in Policy #8130-School Safety Plans and Committees-First Reading

Mr. <u>Simons</u> explained that the State Education Department issued an advisory memo in regards to the types of hardware that school districts can use to secure doorways during a lockdown. He stated that in order to implement some of the recommended lockdown procedures, such as covering door windows or moving furniture in front of the door as an additional barrier, there needs to be a policy. Mr. <u>Simons</u> explained that the policies have been updated to include those provisions.

Mr. Tooker said this change will empower the staff to take measures during a lockdown.

Mr. <u>Mann</u> asked if this only addressed furniture. He stated that there are devices, such as pipes to hold doors closed, available to purchase. Mr. <u>Tooker</u> said that the devices are not deemed fire code compliant, so the district cannot purchase those types of items.

Mr. Simons explained that those items are currently not authorized by the State Education Department.

6. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. East Greenbush CSD District-Wide Safety Plan with Town of East Greenbush SRO Agreement and Rensselaer County Sheriff's Office SRO Agreement

Mr. <u>Simons</u> explained this is a preliminary plan that will be posted on the website for public review and comment for 30 days, and will then be resubmitted at the August 10, 2022 meeting for approval. The Superintendent explained the SRO agreements need to be attached. He stated the Rensselaer County agreement has already been approved by Rensselaer County, but the District is working with the Town of East Greenbush to establish an agreement, and he said it should also be available at the August 10, 2022 meeting for approval. Mr. <u>Tooker</u> added that the new law requiring the installation of the panic buttons will also need to be included in the safety plan, and when it is added it will be brought to the Board as an addendum.

Mr. <u>Mann</u> congratulated Mike Condo, the Columbia High School Resource Officer, on his recent retirement. He thanked him for all he did for the school district and community during his years of service.

B. Board Retreat Date

Mr. <u>Buono</u> asked the Board members if there would be interest in a retreat during the summer or early fall to set and make adjustments to the Board goals and objectives. Mr. <u>Simons</u> said he will provide dates, but does have September 7th, 2022 available, if that would be an option for everyone. Mr. <u>Buono</u> asked the Board members to let him know if that date would be possible.

C. Update on 2022-2023 UPK Program

Ms. <u>Wager</u> discussed the 2022-23 UPK program, stating the District held a lottery in April to choose the 54 students to be enrolled in one of the three classrooms, located in Red Mill, Genet and Donald P. Sutherland. She also shared that the District has an opportunity to partner with the Early Childhood Education Center to provide additional Pre-K slots for District students in an integrated program. Ms. <u>Wager</u> explained that ECEC already has eight students enrolled, and the District would be able to fill the other seven spots with students currently on the waitlist. Ms. <u>Wager</u> also provided the costs, and explained funds from New York State aid and the American Rescue Plan will be used to cover the costs of the program.

Ms. <u>O'Brien</u> asked if the program was financially sustainable going forward.

Ms. <u>Wager</u> stated that the ARP funds are available through September 2024 and she expects the State aid to also continue, but thought it was something that will need to be re-evaluated each year.

Mr. <u>Buono</u> stated that he would like to see results of the kindergarten and first grade progression of the students currently in the program, to see if the program has made an impact. He said the District will need to use that data to decide if the program will continue.
