#### 6. PUBLIC FORUM #1

Mr. Covle thanked the Board and Administrators for the opportunity to work as interim Director of Pupil Personnel Services the last 10 months. He said he felt it was a very rewarding experience, and that he always enjoys working with the East Greenbush Board and staff.

# 7. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS - SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

Mr. Simons gave an update on the Capital Project Planning. He said there will be continued work on the smoke and fire alarm systems at Columbia High School throughout the summer. Mr. Simons stated the District is in the process of sending out an Request for Proposals for a new Architectural firm, and are encouraged by the turn out for the pre-rfp meeting, with six firms in attendance and more inquiries coming in. The Superintendent reported that the playground project at Genet has been submitted and approved by the State Education Department and construction will start in the spring. He said Red Mill's playground will be prioritized in the next capital project.

#### 8. DISCUSSION ITEMS

## A. Proposed Upcycle Project

Mr. Goodwin explained that at this time, the district just disposes of the technology devices, but with the Upcycle Project, a company would take the old devices and give the District revenue, which would help sustain the Chromebook program. He said the company purchases the old devices to use for parts for repairs or refurbishing.

Ms. Skumurki asked about the security and confidentially of giving the technology to an outside vendor.

Mr. Goodwin explained the devices would be powerwashed, and then the company will clean them, as well.

Mr. Buono asked if they will come pick up the devices.

Mr. Goodwin said the company will come right onsite to pickup.

## B. EGCSD Emergency Remote Instruction Plan

Mr. Simons said the New York State Education Department is requiring districts to have an emergency remote instruction plan in place in case of a wide spread health issue, or if a district exhausts its snow days or weather related closures.

Mr. Stiles said in the plan they have addressed that all students have devices and also that all families have connectivity. He explained that elementary students grade K-5 there will be synchronous and asynchronous instruction from 9am - 1 pm. with a minimum of one hour of synchronous instruction. He said they also addressed how all students receive special education services, in a short term closure those services would be asynchronous, but for a long term closure it would transition to synchronous. He said every student would receive an emergency go home folder with supplies. Mr. Stiles said the middle school and high school students would follow a 2 hour delay schedule, with a combination of synchronous and asynchronous instruction.

Mr. Buono asked about the availability of materials on snow days.

Mr. Simons explained the district would know when they have used all the days, and would make sure everyone will be prepared if bad weather is expected.

### C. 2023-2024 EGCSD Professional Development Plan

Mr. Stiles presented the Professional Development Plan for the 2023-2024 school year and highlighted the initiatives and priorities.

Ms. Skumurski thanked the team for giving attention to the middle school.

Mr. Dunn also thanked the team for preparing a plan that ties the professional development plan to the goals of the Board.

## D. Driver Education Proposal for Fall 2023

Mr. Simons explained that over the last few years, the State has changed the requirements of Driver Education due to COVID 19, with the classroom portion taught by the district, but the driving portion was taught by the parents. He said as of June 30, 2023, that model will be discontinued and the districts will have to teach both again, if they decide to offer the class. He said prior to 2020, the District used Bell's Driving School, but they do not have the staff to accommodate district students at this time. He explained that Mr. Tooker has recently taken courses to fulfill the requirement to teach the driving portion, and has located a car they could use for the program. Mr. Tooker explained the proposal. He said that he has located a State contract vehicle that could be purchased, and the district

mechanics said they can make accommodations, such as the additional brake and markings.

Ms. Skumurski said she supports the in school model, but is concerned about students who cannot afford the costs.

Mr. Tooker stated the in the past the district has worked out payment plans, and in cases of extreme hardship the quidance office can offer funding through Equinox.

Ms. O'Brien said she supported the program, as well.

Ms. Kennedy asked if the cost to the District is just the cost of the vehicle.

Mr. Simons said yes, and the parent payments will cover the gas, vehicle maintenance, etc.

Mr. Buono asked the Board if they were in support of the Driver Ed program.

The Board expressed their support, and Mr. <u>Dunn</u> said the most important part is teaching the students to be safe and responsible

# E. Science Research - Recommendation to Approve Summer Hours

Mr. Stiles explained that the Science Research teacher, Heidi Gleason, has been doing an extensive amount of work over the summer to support the program.

He explained to the Board that Ms. Gleason has done this work for the last 16 years, and it recently came to their attention, and they would like to compensate her for up to 50 hours of work this upcoming summer.
