Howard L. Wristbands will be used for entry. The wristbands will be sold for \$10.00. Permission slips should be submitted through ParentSquare and we prefer payments to be made using the PTO's zeffy account. In order to pick up a wristband, your child must have a **COMPLETED PERMISSION FORM** (we will have a list of completed forms) **AND** payment made through zeffy or have cash in hand. Students will be able to pick up their wrist bands during lunch on the 12th, at which time the wristbands will be put on their wrists. Wristbands **WILL NOT** be sold at the door.

The 6th Grade WinterFest Activity Night will be held on January 12, 2024 from 6:00 to 8:00 PM at Goff. Please plan to drop off your child no later than 6:15. Any student dropped off after this time must be escorted to the door by their parent.

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL DANCES AND ACTIVITY NIGHTS

(The EGCS D Code-of-Conduct will be followed)

6th Grade Activity Night
January 12, 2024

1. If a student is absent from school on the day of the dance/activity night, they will not be allowed to attend the dance/activity night.
2. Possession of cigarettes, e-cigarettes and vapes or smoking in the building or on school grounds is prohibited.
3. Embracing, kissing and similar behaviors are prohibited.
4. Pushing, shoving and moshing are inappropriate behaviors and are prohibited.
5. Those who attend must be appropriately dressed. The parents of a student who is improperly attired will be called and the student may be asked to leave.
6. Anyone known to be in possession of, or using, alcoholic beverages or drugs will not be admitted. Anyone known to be in possession of, or using, alcoholic beverages or drugs on school property will be dealt with according to Board of Education policy.
7. No cell phone usage during the event.
8. All chaperones are supervisors. All students will obey the directions given by chaperones.

Please note that no parents will be permitted into the building unless they are signed up to chaperone the event.
