5. BOARD FORUM #1

6. PUBLIC FORUM #1

Ms. Michelle <u>Guzak</u>, district resident and parent of former students, expressed her support of the teachers and urged the Administrators and Board members to try to settle the EGTA contract.

Ms. Jennifer <u>Crewell</u>, district parent and Genet PTO president, expressed her disappointment with the District in regards to the unsettled teacher's contract.

Mr. Scott McNeff, parent of a Columbia High School student, echoed the comments of the other speakers and urged the District to come to an agreement with the teacher's union.

7. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS - SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

A. Capital Project Planning

Mr. <u>Simons</u> stated that the District is working closely with Turner Construction and LaBella Architects to fine-tune the details of the proposed Capital Project. He said they are working to complete an outline of the projects and the costs associated with each project, and plan to bring that information to the Board at a future meeting.

B. Goff Cell Phone Policy Update

Mr. McHugh, Mr. Neumann, Ms. Hoffman and Mr. O'Malley gave an update on the cell phone policy that was implemented at the start of the school year. They provided a report of the student violations and stated that 93.6% of the students have been complying with the new rule that states that cell phones must be kept in lockers during the school day. Additionally, the team presented information from surveys sent to staff, parents and students, and stated that overall the program has been very successful with students being less distracted, socializing more with their peers, and performing better academically than they were before. Mr. McHugh said that given the positive results so far this school year, and with the expectation that benefits will only improve further, the Goff Cell Phone Policy will continue.

8. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Governor's School Aid Proposal

Ms. <u>Simons</u> discussed Governor Hochul's budget proposal and reported that some of the adjustments she has made to the calculations will reduce the District's aid.

Ms. Mulligan summarized the proposal and explained the amounts the District expects to receive.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> said many districts in the county will see a reduction in aid due to these adjustments, and stated the District will be working through the local and regional advocacy committees to try to have this changed. He stated there are two sources of funding to run a district, the State aid and the local property taxes, and said the District and Board try to be balanced in regard to the academic considerations regarding the budget, and also the impact to the taxpayers.

Ms. <u>Skumurski</u> reminded everyone that the amount allocated for Universal Pre-K is limited by not only \$5400 per student, but also by enrollment. She said it looks like the State is allocating a lot of money to the program, but in reality there are a lot of contingencies.

Mr. <u>Simons</u> explained that the allocation only allows for about half the cost per student, and the District has been using the Federal grants to cover the rest, but those funds have been liquidated and now the gap will need to be paid through the general fund.

The Superintendent said this is another issue that districts will need to advocate for, urging the State to change the reimbursement program so more of the money can be allocated towards the cost of the program.

He also said a feasibility study of UPK program is currently occurring through CASDA and will be presented at an upcoming meeting. Mr. <u>Simons</u> stated that the UPK program has been very beneficial to District children, but currently only a portion of the pre-k students can be served. He said they will continue to advocate and also are hoping to address some of the space concerns in the capital project.

B. EGCSD Advocacy Committee Goals for 2024

Mr. <u>Simons</u> explained that the role of the committee is to review issues of the State and Federal governments, and advocate for student and program needs. He said it is important that funding be available to ensure schools can continue to provide high quality academic, extra-curricular and social emotional/mental health supports for all students. He outlined other areas of focus, such as the UPK program allocations, free lunch inequities, school safety and continuing to extend the waiver to allow retirees to return to fill roles for which shortages of qualified applicants exist. The Superintendent reported the committee will be going to the Legislature and meeting with local legislators in February to advocate for more funding and changes to continue to operate the schools.

B. Policy #8130.2 Establishment of Workplace Violence Prevention Policy

Mr. <u>Simons</u> said he is asking the Board to waive the first reading and adopt Policy#8130.2, because the policy is required by the State to be in place by February 3, 2024. Ms. <u>Cannon</u> explained that school districts were originally exempt from this particular law, but as of January 4, 2024 are now required to comply. She reported that the committee has met to work out a policy and then met with representatives of the collective bargaining units to review. She said there are several steps laid out by the Department of Labor that

must all be completed by May 3, 2024, but the policy must be in place to continue. Ms. <u>Cannon</u> said after the policy is adopted, the District will work collaboratively with Questar III BOCES to complete a risk assessment study, and then develop a workplace violence prevention program. She explained the District will be required to provide training to employees on an annual basis.
