Location

Baseball Camp will take place at the East Greenbush Castleton Little League fields and Sorensco Baseball Fields located at the Gilligan Road sports complex adjacent to Goff Middle School. We will use the Goff gymnasium in case of inclement weather.

Camp Schedule

Baseball Camp will be held **Monday through Thursday** from **9:00am – 2:50pm** with morning drop off between **8:50am – 9:00am** each day. Fridays will be used as a rain date.

Morning & Afternoon Sessions

Camp directors will review the day’s agenda and address any questions. Teams will then report to designated fields to rotate through **hitting, fielding, throwing, defensive strategy and position specific instruction**. After lunch, campers will participate in coached pitched scrimmages to develop skills learned in the morning sessions.
