2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

3. EX OFFICIO STUDENT COUNCIL COMMENTS AND PRESENTATIONS

A. Student Council Representatives: Kole Hardy~President; Natalie Krisanda~Vice President
No reports at this time.

B. Assemblymember John T. McDonald III

Assemblymember John McDonald provided an update regarding the New York State budget's impact on education, emphasizing the allocation of \$32 billion to school districts statewide. He discussed a revised foundation aid formula, resulting from a recent study that aimed to modernize calculations. This new formula has resulted in East Greenbush receiving a 5.85% increase in foundation aid. Assemblymember McDonald discussed efforts to increase the cap for CTE instructor salaries from \$30,000 to \$60,000 to address workforce development needs. He also spoke about the ongoing teacher shortage noting that districts rely on retired teachers to fill gaps, but their salaries are capped at \$35,000 annually. He acknowledged the value and competence of these retirees and expressed his intent to propose extending the removal of this cap for another year.

Mr. Simons thanked Mr. McDonald for his support of the proposed waiver, stating that 21 retired employees, including teachers, administrators, bus drivers, and safety supervisors, are currently essential to the district's operations. He emphasized the district's reliance on these individuals and the need to continue the waiver.

Mr. McDonald also discussed the electric bus mandate, and the logistical and financial hurdles many districts face. He stated that while he supports the mandate's intent, he feels the lack of a pilot program and the 2027 deadline are unrealistic. He said he anticipates delays and adjustments, especially after the 2026 elections, and recognized the burden placed on transportation management.

Mr. Buono asked about potential increases to the UPK grant, and asked if there's a possibility of raising the per-student funding to further fund the UPK program.

Assemblymember McDonald said it is very challenging to increase UPK funding, citing existing funding disparities across New York State. While he pledged to advocate for East Greenbush, he noted that districts with long-established UPK programs often receive less per-student funding.

Ms. Skumurski expressed her concern about the affordability of the electric buses. She asked how the state plans to address the financial burden to districts, asking whether there will be funding allocations or if the mandate deadlines will simply be extended.

Assemblymember McDonald acknowledged the significant financial burden of electric buses, stating that NYSERDA is working to assist districts, but the cost remains a major challenge. He suggested a system of annual waivers for districts demonstrating progress, rather than a one-time waiver, to keep them moving forward. He acknowledged the need for financial aid and also noted the current limitations of utility companies. Assemblymember McDonald recognized the competing priorities of environmental goals and taxpayer affordability, and stressed the need for flexibility. He also pointed out the need for new maintenance expertise and civil service positions to handle the unique requirements of electric buses.

C. Bell Top Elementary School Presentation ~ Michael Neumann, Principal

Principal Mike Neumann celebrated the Belltop Book Club's 10th anniversary, emphasizing its successful decade of promoting reading. He and his team showcased how the club has grown student enthusiasm for books through student-led projects, community partnerships, and author visits. Students, both current and former, shared how the club has positively impacted their

reading abilities, social skills, and sense of community.

5. BOARD FORUM #1

Mr. Buono gave an update on the superintendent search. He said the period for submitting applications for the superintendent position has ended, and the search consultants at Questar III are reviewing and will soon present the applications to the Board. He stated the Board will meet on March 11th to review the applications, and expects to begin conducting interviews during the third week of March.

7. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS

A. Capital Project Planning

Mr. Simons provided updates on the capital projects, including the phase 1A project (Columbia High School roof and court replacements) and phase 1B project (Golf Middle School improvements). He noted that planning is proceeding on schedule.

B. Art Program Review

Andrea Neiman, Kate Wargula, and Dianne Chalavoutis presented a review of the art education program. They highlighted the program's mission, accomplishments over the past five years (including navigating COVID challenges), and future goals. Ms. Neiman requested support for technology upgrades, including updated document cameras, digital drawing tablets, 3D printers, and large format printers, and emphasized the importance of keeping the program relevant and comparable to neighboring schools. The department also requested a full-time art teacher at each elementary school to enhance community engagement and cross-curricular activities.

Ms. Skumurski asked what would be involved in providing a full-time art teacher to every elementary school.

Mr. Simons raised financial concerns about the cost of adding full-time art teachers to every elementary school, estimating an additional cost of \$300,000-\$400,000. He stated the possibility of making smaller, gradual improvements if the budget permits.

Mr. Temple and Ms. Steinbach acknowledged the importance of incorporating technology into the art program to prepare students for the future. The Board discussed exploring one-time investments in equipment like 3D printers and digital tablets, and acknowledged the need for ongoing training for the art staff.
