7. PUBLIC FORUM #1

Ms. Sophia <u>Engwer</u>, District parent, expressed her concerns about the Genet Elementary first grade class size, and asked the Board to consider adding an additional section at that level.

8. REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS

A. Modified 9 Soccer

Dr. <u>Kotes</u> explained that parents have previously reached out to ask if a modified 9 soccer team can be added to the athletic offerings. He noted that it is one of only three sports in the District without a modified program, and data from 2024 showed 20 boys were cut from the program due to lack of space with no other opportunity for them to play. He said there has been increased interest in the girls program, as well, so a similar issue might arise. Dr. <u>Kotes</u> explained that a Mod9 program would provide an opportunity for all interested students to participate in interscholastic soccer. He said the teams would compete against other schools in the suburban council, with 12 games scheduled per season. Dr. <u>Kotes</u> said the estimated cost for both teams is \$20,658, which can be reduced in half if one program is not needed. He said the hope is that this new offering will encourage more student involvement, leading to success on and off the field.

B. Class Sizes

Dr. <u>Kotes</u> provided a follow-up to the Board on District class sizes, which the District has been monitoring all spring. He explained that administrators are responsible for class sectioning and are working to maximize resources to create an optimal learning environment while remaining within the approved budget. Dr. <u>Kotes</u> stressed the importance of carefully placing students in classroom groupings to ensure success, even with class sizes that may be increasing. He cautioned against using the small budget contingency for additional staffing, as it's reserved for unforeseen needs like new housing developments or special education requirements. He explained that using these funds early would lead to cuts elsewhere or depleting future reserves, which is not a sustainable model. The Superintendent concluded by stating that while class sizes have ticked up, they are still in line with pre-COVID levels and that no additional hiring is planned at this time unless contract obligations or mandated student needs require it.

C. Strategic Planning

Dr. <u>Kotes</u> updated the Board on the strategic planning process. He explained that the District hired a neutral third-party consultant, Mr. Kevin McGowan from Leadership Solutions, to facilitate the process and provide an unbiased perspective. He said the process began with a community-wide survey that saw high participation and provided valuable feedback. The Superintendent stated that the survey was followed by administrative meetings and an August 5, 2025 community engagement session with students, parents, staff, and Board members. Dr. <u>Kotes</u> explained the next step is for action planning teams to organize the collected data into goals with clear timelines and benchmarks. He said the District wants to make sure that the outcome of this plan, is adaptive, flexible, and it's inclusive of a timeline for achievement. The Superintendent said the final plan will be presented to the Board for recognition and support. Dr. <u>Kotes</u> expressed his gratitude for the high level of community and student participation throughout the process. He also extended his thanks to Mr. Harkin for helping to secure student participants, and he noted his appreciation for the critical questions and valuable perspectives the students brought to the discussion.
