One of the topics that will be discussed is how to incorporate AI within the classroom as we move towards creating a Board of Education policy. Peter is looking for teachers who may be interested in piloting experiences with chatbots using Google's program Gemini to create more individualized experiences and then assist in writing the district's policy.
